ABOUT SIKKIM UNIVERSITY

The permanent campus is being constructed at Yangyang in South Sikkim District, about 56 kilometers from Gangtok. The University at present has 32 full fledged Departments with its Administrative Office located at Samdur, 6th Mile, Tadong, Gangtok.

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

The Department of Zoology was established in the year 2013 and three batches of PG students have successfully passed out from the Department. The Department offers Masters and PhD programmes. The broad focus area of research in the Department is Biodiversity & Conservation Biology, Immunology & Parasitology, and Animal Physiology & Biochemistry. The strength of the Department currently comprises of five permanent faculty members, eight PhD scholars, 40 PG students and one Technical staff.

HOW TO REACH SIKKIM UNIVERSITY

Sikkim University is located at Gangtok, the state capital of Sikkim. Nearest Airport is Bagdogra and nearest railway station is New Jalpaiguri both located at Siliguri, West Bengal. Gangtok is well connected with Siliguri by an all weather road and the distance is approx. 110 kms. Frequent bus and taxi services are available from Siliguri to Gangtok. A new airport at Pakyong, East Sikkim (30 km away from Gangtok) is likely to be functional soon.
