IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRANCE TEST 2019

1. It is mandatory to write assigned **ROLL NUMBER** on the answer sheet.
2. Candidates should report to the examination hall half an hour before the start of examination. No entry shall be allowed after test starts.
3. Candidates must bring black ball point pen for filling entries in the answer sheet.
4. Exchange of pen/pencil/ sharpener etc is strictly not allowed in the examination hall.
5. Use of mobile phone, electronic calculator, log table, slide ruler is not permissible.
6. If the candidate is found in possession of books / any other printed material / any other paper from which he /she might take assistance, he/she is liable to be treated as **DISQUALIFIED**.
7. Candidate are required to bring the printout of the Registration slip along with valid Photo identity proof (Passport/ Aadhar/Voter ID/ PAN/Driving license) without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for test.
8. Candidates are allowed to leave the hall only after 30 minutes of start of examination and have to hand over the OMR sheet as well as Question Booklets to the invigilator. Do not write anything on the question paper.
9. Candidates are advised to locate allocated test centre at least a day in advance to avoid any issue on the day of the test.
10. Travel and staying arrangements will need to be done by the candidates.
