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Notification - 55 /2021

The Committee for preparation of Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for Sikkim University in view of COVID-19 pandemic has recommended the following guidelines for conduct of End Semester Examination 2021 in the University:

(A) FOR INTERMEDIATE SEMESTERS (2nd & 4th UG SEMESTERS, 2nd PG SEMESTER, AND INTERMEDIATE SEMESTERS OF VARIOUS OTHER UG/PG PROGRAMMES)

Composite of Marks for Grading

1. End Semester marks of each paper may be composite of 50% marks on the basis of the internal evaluation (sessional tests for theory, practical and any other category of internal assessment) of the intermediate semester and the remaining 50% comprising from the highest marks obtained in any single paper in any previous End term examinations of the programme/course undertaken including Backlog Papers.

or,

by such programme/distribution of internal and end semester marks prescribed by/applicable as per the scheme of evaluation of the approved curriculum in different programmes of the University.

2. To fix the highest marks, maximum marks obtained in any individual paper from among the previous end term examinations (Odd and Even Semesters of programme undertaken), whether student has passed or failed, may be considered.

3. In situation, where previous semester marks are not available (Theory and Practical), 100 % evaluations may be done on the basis of internal evaluation marks of the current semester. However, if any subject, in any programme is entirely new and unique, modalities may be decided by the concerned Departments/Colleges in consultation with the Controller of Examination.

4. If the student wishes to improve the grades, she/he may appear in special examination for such subjects during next semester as per the UGC Guidelines.



(B) TERMINAL-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS, 2021

Terminal-Semester Examinations, 2021 for Final UG (6th Semester); PG (4th Semester) and Final Semesters of other Professional Programs (Regular and backlog) as well as Backlog Papers (Theory and Practical) of the Courses Completed Students (Even Semesters Only) will be held in Take Home Examination mode as scheduled earlier.

The Vice-Chancellor has approved the above recommendations of the Committee for implementation with immediate effect, subject to ratification by the Academic Council.
